




EEP AFRICA

The Energy and Environment Partnership Trust Fund (EEP Africa) provides early stage grant and catalytic financing to innovative clean energy projects, technologies and business models in 15 countries across Southern and Fast Africa.

EEP Africa focuses on three core activities with the goal of contributing to achievement of the Paris Climate Agreement and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).



EEP Africa is hosted and managed by the Nordic Development Fund (NDF) with funding from Austria, Finland, NDF and Switzerland.

RECENT PORTFOLIO

EEP Africa has invested 56 million euros in 274 projects since 2010. The portfolio reflects the diversity of business models, technologies and thematic areas driving a clean energy revolution in the region.

The recent portfolio consists of 68 companies awarded funding in calls during 2018-2020. They are implementing clean energy projects in 13 countries with a total funding commitment of 24.4 million euros.




