Sistema.bio will strengthen last mile distribution and service capacity through the recruitment and training of new sales agents and technicians. The modular biodigesters will be sold with productive use appliances, offering customers economic savings, increased productivity and income opportunities. With EEP Africa financing, the Sistema.bio will expand into new regions and develop a gender-inclusive approach to recruitment and training.





The project aims to sell 4000 biodigesters and create jobs for more than 80 women. The systems will generate 7,000 MWh of clean energy per year, save EUR 1.1M annually in energy-related expenditure, and reduce 7,400 tonnes of $\rm CO_2e$ emissions by replacing wood, charcoal and other non-renewable energy sources. With a 10-year warranty for each biodigester, the long-term impact of the project is significant.
