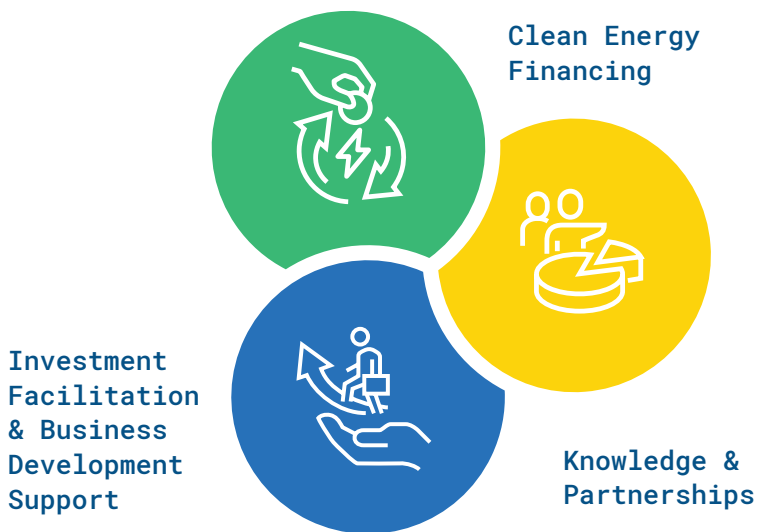




# EEP AFRICA

The Energy and Environment Partnership Trust Fund (EEP Africa) provides early stage grant and catalytic financing to innovative clean energy projects, technologies and business models in 15 countries across Southern and East Africa.

EEP Africa focuses on three core activities with the goal of contributing to achievement of the Paris Climate Agreement and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

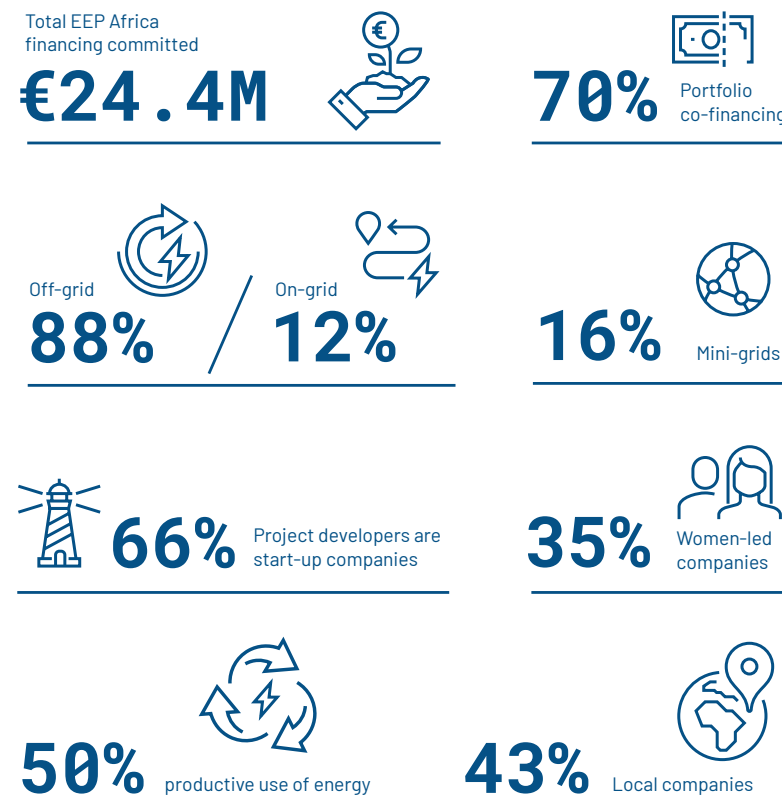
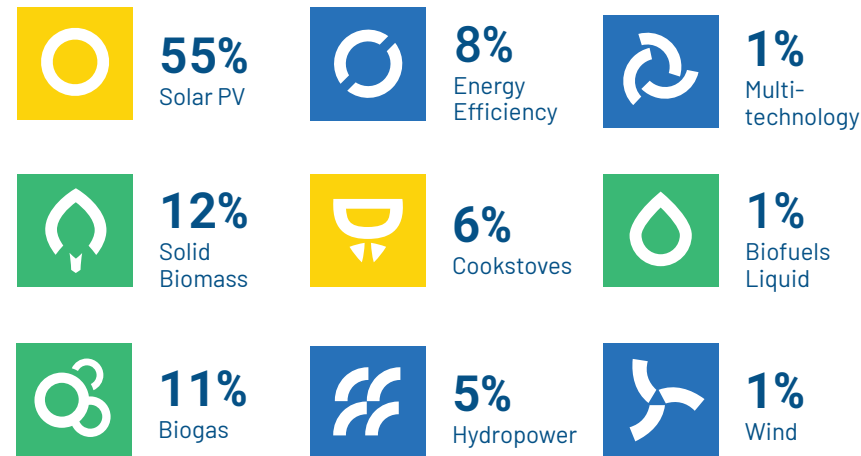


EEP Africa is hosted and managed by the Nordic Development Fund (NDF) with funding from Austria, Finland, NDF and Switzerland.

## RECENT PORTFOLIO

EEP Africa has invested 56 million euros in 274 projects since 2010. The portfolio reflects the diversity of business models, technologies and thematic areas driving a clean energy revolution in the region.

The recent portfolio consists of 68 companies awarded funding in calls during 2018-2020. They are implementing clean energy projects in 13 countries with a total funding commitment of 24.4 million euros.

**EEP Innovation** provides early stage grant financing to projects in active development through competitive, open calls for proposals. EEP Africa has conducted 16 calls since 2010.

**EEP Catalyst** is piloting flexible follow-on debt financing for successful companies from the grant portfolio to close the financing gap and scale up commercially viable solutions.

**Knowledge Exchange Forum:** An open event for clean energy stakeholders on trends and lessons learned.

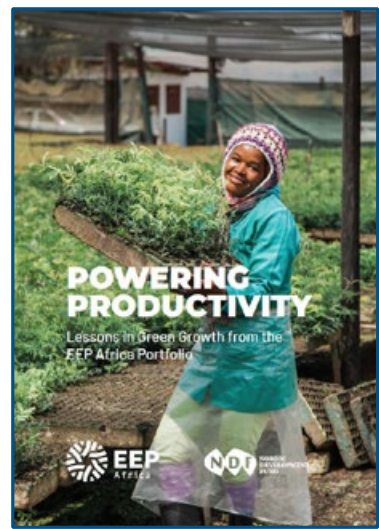
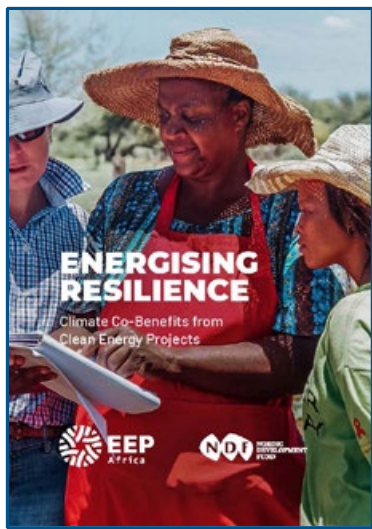
## Awards
